UWG Tuition & Fees: based on 12 hours at in-state tuition rates. Out-of-state students will pay in-state tuition rates while in an exchange program plus a \$250 fee.	\$3,113
Housing (based on standard room with one semester contract and dinner-only meal package)	\$3,200 - \$3,600
Living Expenses (based on \$125 a week for 16 weeks)	\$2,000
Roundtrip airfare to Sydney	\$1,300 - \$1,800
Roundtrip Sydney to Armidale	\$230 - \$310
Health Insurance: OSHC student coverage (purchase through UNE)	\$410
Travel Insurance: iNext, variable coverage (purchase through UWG)	\$87 - \$239
Passport Fee (if you do not have one or yours needs to be renewed)	\$135
Visa Fees – U.S. citizens may be able to complete all visa documentation online. However, if necessary, the Australian Consulate is in Atlanta, GA.	\$500
